BIOGRAPHY



Michael Blazey was elected to the La Habra City Council in November 2010. He served previously on both the La Habra Community Services and Planning Commissions. In December of 2013, he was named Mayor Pro Tem in a unanimous vote by his colleagues on the City Council.

Mayor Pro Tem Blazey's education includes a Ph.D. from Pennsylvania State University, a Master of Science Degree from South Dakota State University, and a Bachelor of Arts from the University of Oregon. His professional career spans decades as an educator, including Associate Professor at Washington State University, research assistant at Pennsylvania State University, and presently, Professor and Director of Academic Facilities at California State University, Long Beach.

Representing the City Council, Mayor Pro Tem Blazey chaired the General Plan Advisory Committee and has been appointed to the Interjurisdictional Planning Forum, the Orange County Library Advisory Board, and as an Alternate Member for the Hillside Open Space Education Coalition (HOSEC).

Mayor Pro Tem Blazey brings his experience as a professional educator and community leader to help strengthen our government agencies, schools and non-profit organizations in developing a greater community.

A 20-year resident of La Habra, Mayor Pro Tem Blazey married La Habra native Jennifer Nestegard in 1991. Their daughters, Amanda and Lauren, are students at Whittier College and Sonora High School respectively.
